Gamble Township Pipeline Release and Repair – Oct. 29 Update

GAMBLE TOWNSHIP (October 29, 2016) – The emergency repair process to replace a damaged Sunoco Logistics pipeline in Gamble Township, Lycoming County, continued today in coordination with local, state and federal regulators. The pipeline, located under Wallis Run at the confluence with Loyalsock Creek, sustained damage on October 21 from the force of a washed-out bridge resulting in the release of gasoline.

Today, PennDOT crews began construction of an emergency bridge across Wallis Run, the first repair priority identified by state and county officials on Friday, October 28. The construction of the emergency bridge by PennDOT will reconnect the north and south ends of Wallis Run Road.

Further updates include:

- Water monitoring results continue to confirm safe drinking water supplies.
- Air monitoring continues to detect no hazardous levels.
- Water and air monitoring will continue under the supervision of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, PA Department of Environmental Protection, and the Lycoming County Department of Safety.
- Per the direction of the PA DEP, soil removed near the damaged pipeline is currently being tested to determine proper disposal methods.
- Sunoco Logistics will continue to work with government stakeholders to help alleviate erosion and other flood damage in the immediate area where possible, following additional PA DEP engineering reviews.
- With local Halloween festivities occurring throughout the weekend, Sunoco Logistics has implemented additional safety protocols in conjunction with the Lycoming County Sheriff's Department, including deploying additional flagger crews and road restrictions.

Sunoco Logistics will continue construction work 24 hours a day, seven days and work is anticipated to take approximately two weeks. The pipeline repair process is expected to generate some noise near construction zones.
