RECIPE CORNER

Glazed Potato Donuts

1 package dry yeast 1/4 cup warm water 1 cup milk, scalded 1/4 cup margarine 1/4 cup sugar 1 teaspoon salt

3/4 cup mashed potatoes

2 eggs - beaten 5 to 6 cups flour

- 1. Dissolve yeast in warm water.
- Combine scalded milk, margarine, sugar, and salt. Cool until lukewarm.
- 3. Stir in yeast, potatoes, and eggs. Add enough flour to make a soft dough.
- 4. Turn onto floured counter and knead until smooth. Place in lightly greased bowl; cover and let rise 1 hour.
- 5. Roll to thickness of 1/2 inch, cut with cutter (or use a glass and bottle cap).
- 6. Place on cookie sheets to raise about 30 minutes. Fry in deep fat in an iron skillet until light brown. Drain on paper towels. Dip in glaze.

GLAZE: Mix 1/2 lb. powdered sugar with 3 tablespoons water and 1 1/2 teaspoon vanilla.



Simple Crockpot Lasagna

1 1/2 pounds hamburger/sausage 1 (16-oz) box lasagna noodles 6 tbsp. butter 1 large container of cottage cheese

1 (8-oz) pkg. shredded mozzarella cheese 1 jar spaghetti sauce

- 1. Brown the meat. Drain off any grease.
- 2. Cook the noodles according to the package directions. Add the butter to the noodles. Stir to melt.
- 3. In a crock pot, layer 1/3 of the noodles, cheeses, browned meat and sauce. Repeat for 2 more layers. Cover and cook on low for about 4 to 5 hours.
