Official Notice of Election for Military and Overseas Voters Lycoming County April 23, 2024 General Primary

This is an official notice of an election to be conducted on April 23, 2024 in Lycoming County. Military and overseas electors may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at www.votespa.com, www.fvap.gov, or the Voter Services website at www.lyco.org/vote. You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to (570) 320-2117 or by email to voterservices@lyco.org.

Military and overseas electors may request an absentee ballot at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the *Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot* (FWAB), available at www.votespa.com, www.fvap.gov, or the Voter Services website at www.lyco.org/vote. Military electors may use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

The FWAB can be used to vote for ALL federal, state, and local offices and ballot initiatives.

To vote, refer to the instructions and page 3 of the FWAB application.

To vote for federal offices (President, U.S. Senator, or U.S. Representative in Congress), write in the name of the candidate of your choice in the space provided on the FWAB.

To vote for state offices, local offices, or ballot initiatives, write the names of candidates or ballot initiatives in the Addendum section of the FWAB. Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum). Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation, or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a Referendum question write YES or NO.
