

# **Work Crew Foreman / RMS Landfill Operations**

Department: Pre-Release Center

#### DESCRIPTION

The Lycoming County Pre-Release Facility Work Crew Foreman will direct the work of minimum-security prison inmate workers engaged in manual work. This is maintenance work at the full performance level. Work involves supervision and accountability of the Pre-Release inmate workers assigned to work at the Lycoming County Resource Management Recycling Center and landfill perimeter support requirements. This position may require skills in a variety of tasks to maintain and repair buildings and grounds, such as painting, light carpentering, ground maintenance and landscaping.

#### **SPECIFIC DUTIES**

- Provide oversight, supervision and accountability of Pre-Release inmate workers assigned to work crews.
- Plans routine repair, custodial, and maintenance jobs in a variety of locations.
- Works closely with the Lycoming County Pre-Release Center Manager and the Lycoming County Resource Management Supervisors.
- Responsible for transporting Pre-Release inmate workers RMS/Landfill.
- Enforcement of rules for all inmate workers, including all disciplinary reports, special incidents, extraordinary occurrences and interviewing.
- Instruct and provide oversite to inmate workers.
- Responsible for tools, materials and other property.
- Responsible for inmate workers discipline and behavior.
- Other duties as assigned by the Work Crew Foreman Supervisor.
- Attend monthly staff trainings as provided by the Pre-Release Center.

#### SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES

Supervises minimum-security prison inmate workers engaged in manual labor.

#### **WORKING CONDITIONS**

There is potential for danger due to equipment and power tools. Subject to all types of weather when working outside. Duties may involve working at different heights.

There is a slight potential for danger due to working with minimum security sentenced inmates.

HOURS: 6:30am - 3:00pm.

### **JOB REQUIREMENTS**

- Fully qualified requirements include a high school diploma and one (1) year related experience.
- Ability to supervise operations of lawnmower, snow blower, leaf vac., small hand and power tools.
- Possession of valid PA driver's license.
- Ability to supervise inmate workers engaged in routine maintenance repair, labor and custodial work.
- Must attend and successfully complete Basic DOC Training.
- Knowledge and ability to utilize computer programs such as Microsoft word, Excel, Outlook, and Internet.
- Ability to drive a 15-passenger van.
- Must be able to pass pre-employment background check and drug screening, as required by Lycoming County.
- Provide basic First Aid to Pre-Release inmates.
- Complete all disciplinary action reports for Pre-Release inmates.
