



The effects are often felt throughout a disabled veteran's entire lifetime and can have an impact on each family member, often in ways that may be quite subtly, or hidden from view.
- Healing and understanding is vital to life success after military service. Each family member will deal with what has happened in their own way. Returning disabled veterans dace the challenge of transitioning from military to civilian life. For many, they feel alone and forgotten. Spouses and children may struggle, first when their loved one being hone and then another adjustment after their return.
- No matter which era a soldier served, ALL PA Disabled Veterans and their families are welcome.


