Official Notice of Election for Military and Overseas Voters Lycoming County May 20, 2025 Municipal Primary

This is an official notice of an election to be conducted on May 20, 2025 in Lycoming County. Military and overseas electors may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at www.votespa.com, www.fvap.gov, or the Voter Services website at www.lyco.org/vote. You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to (570) 320-2117 or by email to voterservices@lyco.org.

Military and overseas electors may request an absentee ballot at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the *Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot* (FWAB), available at www.votespa.com, www.fvap.gov, or the Voter Services website at www.lyco.org/vote. Military electors may use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

The FWAB can be used to vote for ALL federal, state, and local offices and ballot initiatives.

To vote using the FWAB, fill out and send in the **Voter Information** and the **Official Backup Ballot**.

To vote for offices or ballot initiatives, write the names of candidates or ballot initiatives in the appropriate section of the FWAB. Under the **Federal Offices** heading, enter the candidate name or political party you choose. Under the **Other Offices** heading, enter the state or local office, and then the candidate name or political party you choose. Under the **Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the title of the ballot initiative (referendum) you are voting on and then write YES or NO.

- Photocopy this page if you require additional room for candidates or ballot initiatives.
- If you are voting in American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico, or the U.S. Virgin Islands, you may vote for Delegate or Resident Commissioner, and in presidential primaries. State laws vary about using the FWAB for other offices like Governor or Mayor. Learn more online at FVAP.gov.
